**We made a prediction to start. Then we created a fair test. We recorded our results and drew a conclusion from it.**

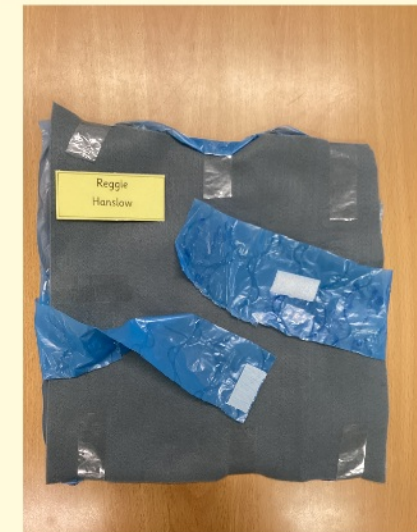
