We made a prediction to start. Then we created a fair test. We recorded our results and drew a conclusion from it.

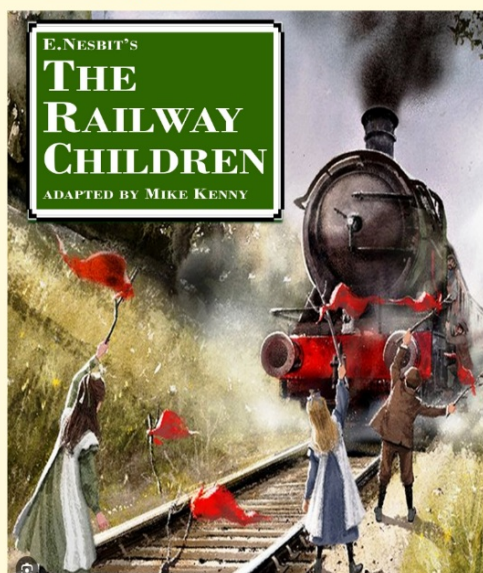

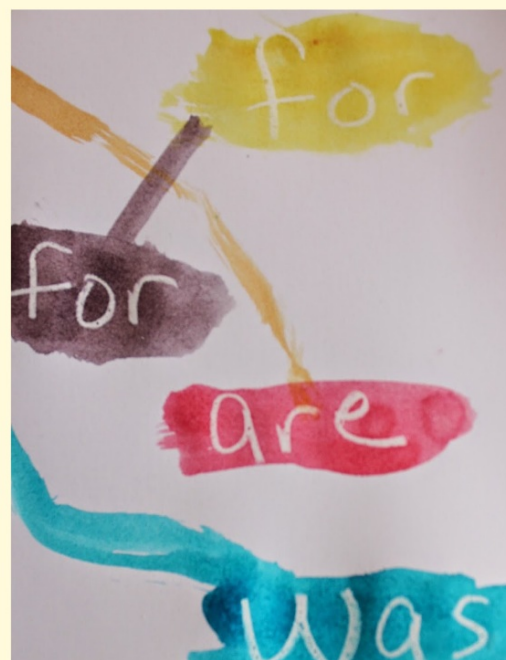


Ways to support your child:

Clothes- Name everything. Please makes sure jumpers and coats are in school every day.

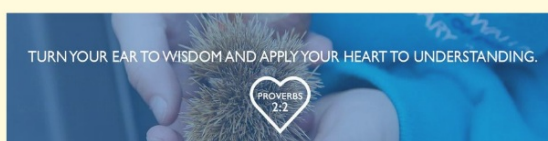


As a healthy school, we can't allow sweets to be given out to the class as a way to celebrate a birthday. This is also for the safety of children with allergies/ diabetes.
