


**Bookbags need to be in school

Named water bottles need to be in daily.




Named coats must be in school every day as the weather is cold.



Maths

Life skills - using money, telling the time, weighing (cooking etc.)


Wear a watch - analogue (please make sure this is not a smart watch - no camera or video making tools)

Numbots - keep practising!



Reading- please record each book your child reads in their Reading diary. This is so important for seeing the range of books your child is reading.

Spelling- talk about the meaning of the word, can your child put it into a sentence? Can they use it appropriately?

By the end of Year 2, your child should be able to join up their handwriting.




Homework - CGP books

Encourage the children to do jottings in the CGP book or in their homework book.




This will start this week.

Let us know how the children have done on Google Classroom by writing a comment.


Child A has used their jottings independently. They found question 4 tricky because they couldn't regroup.
