Reading- please record each book your child reads in their CAPER diary. Not just the school books. This is so important for seeing the range of books your child is reading.


Spelling- talk about the meaning of the word, can your child put it into a sentence? Can they use it appropriately?

Each week we will reference the pages the children need to do on Google Classroom.




Work with your child. Not to be done on their own.

Answers are at the back of the booklets: for parents only. Parents- please mark it at home, there is no need to bring it into school.




Let us know how the children have done on Google Classroom by writing a comment.
