

Early Years

73.3% of Broadwater children achieved a good level of development (GLD) at the end of Early Years.

This compares to 71% for West Sussex and 70% nationally.

Year 1 Phonics Screening

93.3% of Broadwater children achieved the expected standard in phonics at the end of Year 1.

This compares to 81% nationally.

Expected Standard - a pupil must have a scaled score of 100 or more in reading and mathematics; and have been teacher assessed in writing as 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at greater depth in the expected standard'.

Higher Standard - a pupil must have a high scaled score in reading and a high scaled score in mathematics; and have been teacher assessed in writing as 'working at a greater depth'. The high scaled score value in mathematics and reading is released by the DfE, after the key stage 2 tests have been sat in the summer term. This value will remain 'Pending' until that time.

National Outcomes: Reading (Test) 71%, Writing (TA) 76%, GPS (Test) 77%, Maths (Test) 75%, RWM combined 61%

West Sussex Outcomes: Reading (Test) 70%, Writing (TA) 69%, GPS (Test) 74%, Maths (Test) 71%, RWM combined 55%

Progress

The progress score for reading was +1.93 (confidence interval +0.40 to +3.47)

The progress score for writing was – 2.86 (confidence interval -4.35 to -1.36)

The progress score for maths was -1.03 (confidence interval -2.42 to +0.36)
