RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) curriculum

The Department of Education have released a new RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) curriculum that comes in to force from September 2026 and we have been working hard to adapt our learning journey to encompass the changes required.

They have not taken anything out of the old document they have just simplified and clarified certain points.

One of the main amendments is to support parents in knowing what we are teaching and the language/ resources we are using, to ensure transparency and to further develop our home school relationship.

In order to achieve this, each year group will provide regular updates with what is being covered each term and provide some of the questions and the language that we will be using to discuss these topics. We will also suggest that you may wish to be more involved by beginning these conversations at home and how you can support the learning.
