Year R – Coombes & Lancing College Farms Trip **Wednesday 11th June 2025**

We are starting our 'Fantastic Farms' topic at the beginning of the second half of our summer term and to enhance our learning we will be making a trip to Coombes Farm and Lancing College Farm on Wednesday 11th June. This is an exciting and valuable experience for the children, who will have a range of first-hand experiences including looking at farm machinery, cattle and learning about a farmer's job and environment.



The cost of the visits (coach travel and entrance fee to Coombes farm) will be **£17.20**, for which we invite you to make a contribution of this amount. If you are already signed up with *PARENTPAY*, you can pay this online by debit or credit card and at the same time giving consent for your child to take part in this trip. If sufficient funds are not provided by parents/carers it will be impossible for the school to meet the cost and the visit may be cancelled.

Information for our trip to the farm:

Children will need:

- To wear suitable, comfortable, non-uniform clothes but with the school jumper.
We recommend that legs are covered even in warm weather due to stinging nettles.
- To wear suitable **enclosed footwear (no sandals)**, if the weather has been fine then trainers will be acceptable and if wet then please wear wellies.
- For hot weather; please have sun block already applied, plus a sun hat and plenty of water.
- A small backpack with a bottle of water, a light waterproof and **a packed lunch to be provided by parents unless specifically requesting a Chartwells packed trip lunch via ParentPay, (all hot dinners to be cancelled by Thurs 29th May at the latest).** Please ensure there are no products containing nuts of any kind.

Inhalers and auto injectors that are normally kept in the classroom will be taken and returned to class on the day. If children require prescribed medicines, these must be accompanied by a medicines form (obtained via the office), in their original packaging (including the label with the prescribed dose and the patient information leaflet). Non-prescribed medication (e.g for travel-sickness) must also be in its original packaging, and accompanied by a completed medicines form (obtained via the office).

For your information each class will be leaving by coach at different times and both will return to school before home time.
