



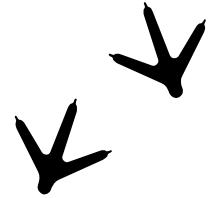
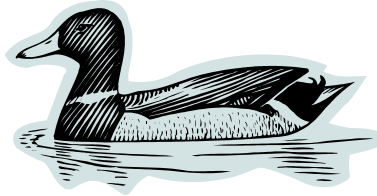

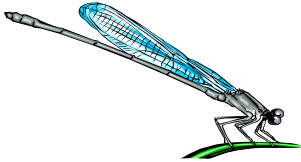
Dear Year 1 Parent/Carer,

Year 1 - Trip to Arundel Wetlands Centre (plus Bee Keeper Visitor)

taking place separately for each class as follows:

Robin Class - Thurs 2nd July (Cost: £22.15)

Dove Class – Friday 3rd July (Cost: £22.15)



During this term, Year 1 have two exciting learning opportunities: firstly, we will be doing some learning around pollinators and finding out how good our school grounds are for supporting them. We have invited a member of the Worthing Bee Society to come into school to talk to the children during the summer term. She will bring along some amazing interactive resources for the children to look at and explore. The cost of this is £1.40 per child which has been added to the summer term trip cost below.



We have planned our summer term trip to the **Arundel Wetlands Centre** separately for each class (see dates above). The purpose of the visit is to enhance our studies of the life processes and living things element of our topic. The children will be travelling in a coach leaving school by 9.15am and returning by 3.15pm.

Children will need:

- Suitable outdoor long trousers (to protect from thorns and brambles) plus school uniform top/s.
- Lightweight waterproof coat (in case of rain).
- Sun hat for hot weather (**ensure your child has sun cream applied before arriving at school**).
- Comfortable Shoes (not sandals) or wellington boots (if wet).
- A small backpack that your child can carry.
- A carton of drink and a small snack e.g. apple/banana for mid-morning.
- **Water bottle sufficient for a full day & Packed Lunch (to be provided by parents – please ensure there are no products containing nuts of any kind).*** - *If, however, you would prefer Chartwells to provide a trip packed lunch then **please order this via ParentPay by 18th June at the latest.**

To cover the cost of the visit which includes transport and field study activities held at the Arundel Wetlands Centre (including our Bee visitor), we are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£22.15** to be paid via MCAS this will then automatically give consent. We will, of course, always be ready to help in cases of genuine financial difficulty – please email in confidence to finance@broadwaterce.org

Inhalers and auto injectors that are normally kept in the classroom will be taken and returned to class on the day. If children require prescribed medicines, these must be accompanied by a medicines form (obtained via the office), in their original packaging (including the label with the prescribed dose and the patient information leaflet). Non-prescribed medication (e.g for travel-sickness) must also be in its original packaging, and accompanied by a completed medicines form (obtained via the office).

Please contact the school office to let us know if you are able to help on the trip (you will need to have a current Broadwater DBS).
