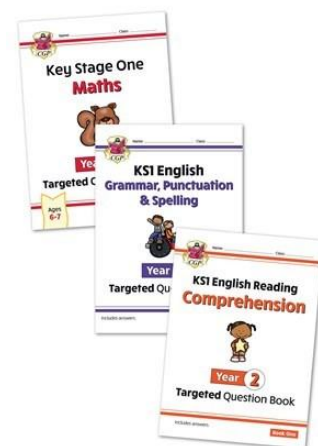

Dear Parent/Carers,

Yr 2 CGP Books for Homework – Spring Term 2026

I am writing to explain the important ways we are planning to help and support your child in achieving well in Key Stage 1. To support the children's learning, we know that the children would benefit from having additional material to take home.

In order to provide a clear structure, we have purchased an extensive range of support material (CGP books). This material will reinforce what has been taught in class and will act as a revision and over learning tool. We have used similar materials in the past and have seen the positive impact they have made on the children's learning.



We will be starting to use the CGP books in Maths and English for **Homework in the Spring term**. Usually, these books retail at £16.25. The school are able to buy these books at a considerably reduced cost of £6.00 per child which represents excellent value for money and an important way of helping your child. With this material, it should not be necessary for any parent to purchase other material that is on the market.

We are asking you for a voluntary contribution of £6.00 per child to pay for the homework material which children will write in and keep as a key revision tool. This can be paid for via the School Shop on MCAS. Please see the guide below if needed.
(Note: if you are using a desk/laptop computer then go to 'Broadwater C of E Payment.)

We are always happy to help with this cost in the case of financial need and ask that you speak to the school finance assistant in confidence about this should you need to.

I hope that you can see we are keen to support all the pupils to achieve their best, and there is much research to support the view that education is most successful when it takes place in partnership with and cooperation between pupil, home and school. We look forward to enhancing this partnership.
