## Year 3 Trip to Butser Ancient Farm, Hampshire Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2025

To complement our Summer Term topic "Digging Deep" we have organised a trip to Butser Ancient Farm on **Tuesday 10**<sup>th</sup> **June**.

Children will need be at school for 8.15am ready for a prompt departure, arriving back at school by 3.30pm. The purpose of this trip is to enable the children to have first-hand experience of what it was like to live in the Stone Age with the opportunity of four different activities: cordage, archaeology, wattling and pottery.



Please note that the children will spend most of the day out of doors so it is important that the children are suitably dressed and protected from the day's weather.

## The children will need:

- Old everyday clothing and suitable shoes for taking part in 'messy' activities (please note that it can be quite muddy on site as well).
- A light waterproof jacket in case of rain (or to use for sitting on for lunch).
- For hot weather; please have sun block already applied, plus a hat and plenty of water.
- Small backpack.
- Lunch and non-fizzy drink (no glass please) wrapped in a plastic bag (no lunch boxes please).

## The children will NOT need

- Cameras
- Money

The cost of the trip will be £23.20 for which we invite you to make a contribution of this amount. If you are already signed up with PARENTPAY, you can pay this online by debit or credit card and at the same time giving consent for your child to take part in this trip. If sufficient funds are not provided by parents/carers it will be impossible for the school to meet the cost and the visit may be cancelled.

As a reminder if you have already booked and paid for school hot lunches for this date please make sure you cancel this in plenty of time (**by 29<sup>th</sup> May**). If you are entitled to a free school meal then you can book a Chartwells trip packed lunch via ParentPay by the deadline.

Inhalers and auto injectors that are normally kept in the classroom will be taken and returned to class on the day. If children require prescribed medicines, these must be accompanied by a medicines form (obtained via the office), in their original packaging (including the label with the prescribed dose and the patient information leaflet). Non-prescribed medication (e.g for travel-sickness) must also be in its original packaging, and accompanied by a completed medicines form (obtained via the office).

As with most trips, we will need adult helpers on the trip although you must have a current school DBS in place. Please contact the school office to register your interest.
