YEAR 6 - END OF YEAR ACTIVITIES

As we approach the end of Year 6, we are keen to mark the end of the children's time at Broadwater with a number of 'leavers' activities.

Disney's The Lion King Jr Production

We are thrilled to be able to invite you in to school to watch the performances for our end of year production this year.

You will have received a **separate letter** regarding tickets and performance times and arrangements. Each cast will have one afternoon and one evening performance. The dates for these performances are Tuesday 14th July 2pm/6:30pm and Wednesday 15th July 2pm/6:30pm.

Final Credit Treat Water Fight- Mon 13th July (during the school day)

For the final credit treat, we have planned a giant water fight on the field! For this day, your child will need to **wear their PE kit** and bring in a **small water pistol and a towel** (and possibly a change of clothes if they are going to Wrap Around after school). Please do not feel obliged to buy a hugely expensive pistol especially for this - just something small will be sufficient if your child would like to take part.

Year 6 Leavers Party and BBQ- Mon 20th July (7:00pm-9:00pm)

We will be celebrating the end of term with a Year 6-only Leaver's Party on Monday 20th July. The party will start at **7.00pm** and end at **9.00pm**. Children will need to be dropped at the hall entrance of the playground at 7:00pm.



We would encourage the children to dress smartly to celebrate the end of primary school (no football kits please!) As part of this evening, we have arranged for a photo booth to be set up, providing the children with a source of entertainment as well as the opportunity to take home a more lasting memory of the evening with their friends.

The children will be able to choose from a variety of props and can have a photo with small groups of friends. They will be able to take photos home on the night as printed postcards and can have an unlimited number of photos with their friends during the evening.

We will provide the children with a BBQ for their party food. We will cater for food and drink and are asking for a **£10.00** contribution from each child, this will cover the cost of food, drink and the photo booth. We have all of the up-to-date dietary information from our trip to Lodge Hill; however, if anything has changed regarding your child's diet or allergies, please let the office know.

Please note: all children will need collecting by an adult at 9pm. as we will not allow children to walk home alone. Please collect from the hall end of the main playground - we will open the black gates for you at the end of the party. Please let us know if the emergency contact number for the evening is different to our records.

Last day of term - Tuesday 21st July

School Leavers' Service (9:15am-10:30am)- Parents invited

On the last day of term, our Year 6s will lead a leavers' service at St Mary's Church in Broadwater. Parents and carers are very welcome to attend this service and join the children as they reminisce on their time at Broadwater (tissues are advised!) If you wish to attend, please arrive at St Mary's church from 9.15am, ready for a 9.30am start.

Last day, goodbyes and shirt signing

We allow children to make a 'signed shirt' as a keepsake on the last day of term. You must provide a **second school T-shirt** for this if you would like your child to be involved, as they will not be permitted to use the one they are wearing on the day. Your child will need to bring in their own marker pens for this (Sharpies or similar markers are best) and they will have the opportunity to write on everyone's shirt in the year group during the day. If you would prefer, your child can bring in a notebook for signing.

End of the day

If you are planning to collect your child at the end of the day on their final day, we will dismiss them, in style, from the hall into the playground so come and join us there at 3:15!
