Dear Parent/Carers,

Year 6 Trip to Shoreham – Thursday 1st October

As part of our topic 'From Coast to Coast', we are planning a visit to Shoreham-by-sea. We will be visiting two locations during the day: Shoreham Port, to find out about the imports and exports, local land use, influence of the port on the development of the town; and the RNLI Life Boat station, to learn about their role in keeping safe in the harbour.



The date of the visit is **Thursday 1st October** and we are planning to travel to and from Southwick station by train. Please could you arrange for your child to meet us outside the entrance to **Worthing Central Station Booking Hall** between 8.45am-9.00am, at the latest (we plan to catch the 09:22 train).

On the way home, we will be catching the 14:39 train from Southwick. Please arrange for your child to be collected from Worthing station by 15:00 (the train is due to arrive at 14:53). We will need to know the arrangements for your child's pick up when we return to Worthing station or permission to walk home alone, please click on the following link: [Y6 Shoreham Harbour trip - Thursday 1st October 2026 – Fill in form](#) We will only let children walk home alone after the trip if you have specified this on the form.

The cost to the school, assuming all of the year 6 pupils take part, will be **£4.00** per child paid via MCAS and automatically gives consent for this trip. In the event that we do not have sufficient contributions to fund this trip, it may be cancelled. We will, of course, always be ready to help in cases of genuine financial difficulty – please do speak in confidence to the School Finance Assistant.

Your child will need to be wearing suitable clothing for being outside - whatever the weather. They will need a **waterproof coat** and shoes that are suitable for walking (trainers are fine). Children should wear the **school uniform top** and their own **comfortable trousers**. They will need a packed lunch and a drink, but no nut products, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.

Inhalers and auto injectors, which would normally be kept in the classroom and in the medical room, will be taken out on the trip, on the day. If children require prescribed medicines, they must be in their original packaging, which must include the label with the prescribed dose and the patient information leaflet. Non-prescribed medication (e.g for travel-sickness) must also be in its original packaging, and include dosage details. **You must complete a form at the office if you require staff to administer this medication.**
