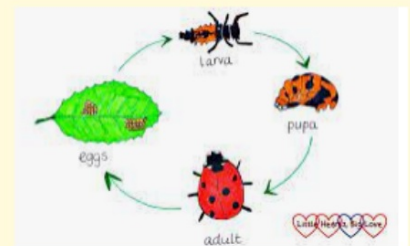
Classifying
