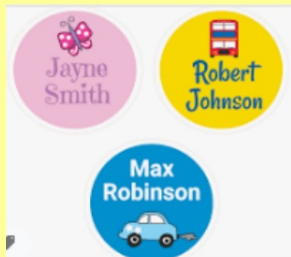

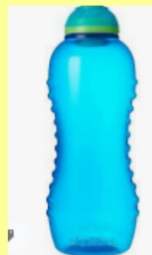

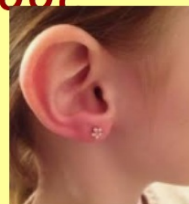


A COAT EVERY DAY

Guided reading book

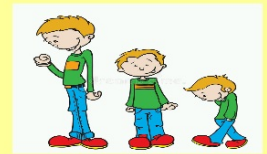
